1. What is one thing that you're hoping for during this Christmas season?
2. Read the following verses:
 - a. Isaiah 9:6
 - b. Luke 2:13-14
 - c. Romans 5:1-2Discuss the peace that Jesus brings and who receives it. Is this something you often think about? In what ways can a habit of reflecting on these truths affect us?
3. Read John 14:25-27. How is the Holy Spirit connected to the peace Jesus promises?
4. Read Galatians 5:22-23 and Philippians 4:6-7. What kind of peace is being described here?
5. Peace that doesn't make sense—that is what is promised to us. Have you ever been flooded with the peace of God in a situation when it didn't make sense for you to have it? What happened?
6. There are times when we can feel overwhelmed by situations that are beyond our control and we pray for God's peace. Then there are times when we feel overwhelmed, anxious, and fearful and we've contributed to why we feel that way, yet, we still pray for God's peace. What should be our expectations in both of these situations? What do we need to do?
7. Take action:
 - a. Who is one lost person you are praying for right now who needs peace with God that only Christ brings? Share with the group and have the group commit to pray for them.
 - b. Do you need peace in a certain situation in your life right now? Share with the group and take a moment to pray after each request is shared.
