6. Read Matthew 6:19-21. What does Jesus teach us about our financial resources in these passages? What stands out to you from these verses and why?
7. Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-8. In the sermon Bobby pointed out that our financial giving can be a test of how we listen to the Spirit, of what is going on in our hearts, and it is a test of faith. Do you see that point being made in these passages and how? What do these verses teach that is most meaningful to you personally and why?
8. How can we pray for each other this coming week?
