- 1. Who has been a spiritual mentor or encourager in your life, and what did they teach you? Why is it important, especially with our Lost and Found Theme in 2025, that we look for unchurched people to encourage and even mentor?
- 2. Read Romans 11:1-6. What stood out to you from the sermon and from these verses? *Please note the extra resources on how Christians can think about Israel and Romans 11 that are on The Harpeth Hub.
- 3. Have you ever experienced a time when you felt rejected by God—or wondered if He had given up on you? What helped you through that?
- 4. Paul talks about being part of God's people because of God's grace, not works. How does that truth affect how you see your own spiritual journey?
- 5. Elijah felt isolated and alone in his faith. Have you ever felt like you were almost the only one trying to follow God faithfully? Describe that experience.
- 6. God reminded Elijah that there was a faithful remnant still following Him. Who in your life has been part of that "remnant"—faithful people who encourage you to keep trusting God? How can each of us be like that for other people?
- 7. In what area of your life do you need to rest more fully in God's grace instead of striving to earn His favor?
