Read Romans 13:1-7 and discuss the following:

- 1. What does Paul mean when he says, "there is no authority except that which God has established" (v.1)? How does this shape our understanding of God's sovereignty in relation to human governments?
- 2. Are there limits to the obedience Christians owe to the state? When, if ever, is civil disobedience justified for a Christian? Can you think of biblical or historical examples?
- 3. What should you do if an authority figure (at work, in government, in family) asks you to do something you believe is wrong? Have you ever had to choose between obedience to God and obedience to a human authority? How did you handle it?
- 4. How can an unsubmissive attitude toward governing authorities point to our own struggle to submit to God's authority?
- 5. In what ways does submission to human authorities serve the greater mission of the Church? How might rebellion, or even apathy toward authority, hinder the gospel?
- 6. How can we be an example for Christ to our family, our neighborhood, workplace, or online, by the way we submit to and engage with authority?
- 7. How often would you say that you pray for those in authority over you? How can we encourage each other to make this a common practice in our day-to-day lives?

End your group by praying for each other.
