Assign the following passages be read aloud: Romans 14:1-12; Romans 14:13-23; Romans 15:1-13

- What kinds of "disputable matters" (v1) might Paul be referring to in today's church?
 How do we discern between essential, important and personal elements in doctrine and practice?
- 2. Who are the "strong" and the "weak"? How does the phrase "Love surpasses Liberty" describe how we are to treat those whose opinions regarding non-essentials differ from our own?
- 3. How should the Lordship of Christ (vs. 7-9) shape our view of fellow believers?
- 4. What are examples of how we could cause a brother or sister to stumble (v13)?
- 5. In verse 17, Paul says the kingdom of God is not about eating and drinking. What *is* it about, and how should that shape our focus as a church? Is there an area where your freedom might be negatively affecting someone else?
- 6. Paul ends with hope (15:13). How does true Christian unity in diversity become a powerful witness to the world?

Next steps:

- Is there anything you do (past/present) that you now realize could be causing another brother or sister to stumble? What will you do to make it right?
- What is one action you can take this week to build up another believer in love, especially someone who sees things differently than you?
