1. What is something from this last week for which you are thankful. Explain why?
2. Read Acts 4:1-21
3. What was God prompting you with on the Sunday teaching on this passage? Explain?
4. Talk about God's miraculous power. How rare was the healing of man (initially described in Acts 3) back then? How rare is this kind of thing today. Why did you answer that way? How do you feel about God acting this way today and does this passage offer anything that helps our perspective?
5. Which is the greater miracle: God healing a crippled man (Acts 3) or God saving 5,000 (Acts 4:4)? Explain why?
6. What does Acts 4:12 teach? How do people react to this kind of statement today and why? What do you want to do in light of the teaching of this verse?
7. What is the main point of Acts 4:13? What would it take for people to say that about you today? How inspired are you to become that kind of person? What actions are you willing to take this coming week to respond to this teaching?
8. How can we pray for each other this coming week?
