1. Start with an update: What is the biggest thing that happened in your life this past week?
2. Prepare - What is your perspective on Jewish people today? What do you think about them? What do you think the small Jewish population in the world today (about 13 million) do not believe in Jesus?
3. Read Acts 10:1-11:17.
4. What is God say to you – either through the sermon or as you read this text? Explain>
5. Which experience is more interesting to you: 1) the reasons that God picked Cornelius or 2) the Peter's hesitation about bringing the gospel to non-Jews? Explain.
6. How do you resolve the question of how much a person needs to know about Jesus before they can be baptized?
7. What needs to happen in your life, like it did for Peter, so that God can use you to reach more lost people? Explain?
7. What is the top thing that stands out to you from this chapter that you want to put into practices in your own life and why?
8. How can we pray for each other this week?
