3. What are some “Jesus plus” examples you have experienced?
4. What are some ways you can foster a spirit of “unity and love” in your home group?
5. What is the role(s) of works in the Christian life? Why are they important? Are works in opposition to grace and faith? Why? Or why not?
6. What is God saying to you – either through the sermon or the text?
7. What lesson from today’s discussion can you put into practice and apply this week?
