

# Disciple Making:

## Lessons Learned in Uganda

Making disciples like Jesus did takes place within **community** through **relationships**.

We decided to be intentional in the following ways:

- **Prayer**-Holy Spirit's guidance
- **Identification**-who are we discipling? Are they willing?
- **Environment**-Where does disciple making take place?
- **Prioritizing**-We have to make time in our schedules.
- **Content**-What are we studying? Is it best for where a person is on their spiritual journey?
- **Accountability**-Are we willing to be accountable to each other? Can obedience to God's word be seen in our life? Are we committed to what we say we will do?
- **Transparency**-Are we willing to be open? Are we willing to be vulnerable? Are we willing to be *known*?
- **Confidentiality**-What is said when we meet stays with us.

The gospel message isn't supposed to **terminate** on us. We're all called to make disciples.

From Christ the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in **love**, as each part does its **work**.
