Acts 18:1-4, 24-28

Paul **pours** his life (his testimony and complete knowledge of the Gospel) into Aquila and Priscilla. This is what **disciple makers** do.

Aquila and Priscilla were a **team**-a beautiful picture of a Christ-centered marriage.

Apollos demonstrated **humility**. Once someone has been schooled in one view it can often mean that they are least teachable for another. Apollos was open.

Without a better understanding of Scripture, we can perpetuate teachings which are **incomplete** or simply **untrue**.

We don't get to decide what Scripture means according to how we **feel**.

As we seek a better understanding together, we should recognize the importance of **environment** and **approach**.
