### Small Group Questions

1. Make sure that everyone knows everyone else in the group. Then, answer this question:  
*what is something important to you that happened in your life this past week?*
2. Read Acts 19:1-20. See if you can verbally reprise what the text is saying without reading it – in other words, tell the stories in your own words.
3. What did you sense God saying to you when you heard *the sermon*? Explain.
4. Which teaching in this text is the hardest for you to personally relate to (explain):
  - a. The indwelling Holy Spirit is the difference between being a true Christian or not.
  - b. God can and does do extraordinary miracles.
  - c. Demons are real and can be cast out by the name of Jesus.
5. What, in your opinion, will it take for us to see the same dramatic spiritual power that we read about in this text today? Explain.
6. Our elders pray together every Thursday morning and we invite everyone to fast with us every Monday. How can we encourage more people to engage in fasting and prayer? How can we encourage you to more fully engage?
7. Does this kind of text cause you to want to learn more about prayer and the power of the Holy Spirit in your life? If so, how can you 'draw near to God, so he can draw near to you' (James 4:7-8)?
8. What is one thing you want to do this week to put these teachings into better practice in your life?
9. How can we pray for each other?
