



“A Radical Conversion”

Acts 22:1-21

Group Discussion Guide

What stood out to you the most from today’s service?

Read Acts 22:1-5 - What’s the significance of Paul’s own story in this setting?

Have you ever heard someone’s story and thought, “This sounds just like mine?” How did it affect you?

Have you ever been in a situation where you’ve been able to speak into someone’s life because you shared a similar journey? What happened?

Read Acts 22:6-7 - then read below:

Jesus asks Saul, “**Why do you** persecute me?”

If you prayed this morning during the service, did you sense Jesus pointing out something specific in your life? If you are willing, share it with the group.

(example: “**Why do you** pretend like everything is ok.”)

Read Acts 22:10-16 - How do these verses describe Paul’s response and his willingness to obey?

Do you have a response to the “Why do you...?” question? Do you believe that you are able to do something about it? Why or why not? If you are willing, share this with the group. Ask a group member to pray for the things which are shared.
