Home Group Questions
February 23, 2020**

1. How are you doing – introduce any guests and go around and briefly share how are you doing?

2. God’s Word – read Genesis 2:1-24 ... what stands out to you from the teaching at Harpeth on these passages during the Sunday teaching?

3. We want to focus on what Genesis 2 teaches about marriage in our discussion. Read what Jesus said in Matthew 19 about the teaching on marriage in Genesis 2.

Matthew 19:4-6 - “Haven’t you read,” he replied, “that at the beginning the Creator ‘made them male and female,’ and said, ‘For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh’? So they are no longer two, but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, let no one separate.”

- What does Jesus tell us about the foundations of a marriage in this passage? How do we apply that today?
- What do the principles Jesus emphasizes in passage tell us about living together and homosexual marriage?
- What is Polyamory and why are many saying that it is becoming popular and will continue to become popular?
- How can we encourage one another to uphold marriage as a sacred covenant that God joins together?
- How does Jesus want us to understand this expression: “what God has joined together, let no one separate”?

4. If anyone in your group has joined the webinars, describe some of the positive aspects or some of the positive things that you have learned.

5. Ask the question – “how can we pray for each other this coming week”?
