Group Discussion Guide

What stood out to you from today's service?

Read Genesis 9:20-21 and discuss the following:

- What is your first thought about Noah's behavior?
- Do you think we sometimes elevate our heroes/leaders within Christianity to an unhealthy height? Maybe we think they shouldn't struggle with sin like everyone else? What happens when we do this?
- Why do you think it can be easy for our faith or witness to become "relaxed" around those we're closest to? How have you experienced the effects of this? Is there something you need to do to change it?

Read Acts 17:26-28. How does this passage work together with **Genesis Chapter 10**? In what ways does it encourage you?

Think about the nations of the world—the differences in language, culture, beliefs, etc. Considering how vastly different they are all, it has the potential to make us feel disconnected, overwhelmed, and maybe even disinterested. **Read Galatians 3:26-29.** How does this affect your worldview? How does it impact your daily life? Your mission?

Read Genesis 11:1-9.

What is the main problem with people as described in these verses?

How does the arrogance of humanity seen here manifest itself in our world today?

Do you rely on accomplishments to define your worth? Have you ever? Have they become an object of worship? What are you going to do about it? Is there any way this group can help?
