## How Do We Love Like Jesus? Pt. 1

Group Discussion Guide

**Read Mark 12:28-31 and John 13:34-35.** What was significant about the *new* command Jesus gave regarding love?

**Read John 3:16 and 1 John 3:16.** What is the example we're to follow? What does this look like practically? (Be specific to your own life.)

What would we be like if we acknowledged God's grace every day? Take that a bit deeper—imagine the reality of Christ's sacrifice is something that you carry with you into your conversations and actions. What could that look like? How would it change the way you love? How will you apply this this week?

**Sanctification means "being made holy."** It's not something which is already completed; it's a process. Jesus talks about this in **John 17:13-17**. How does he say the disciples will be sanctified? What do you suppose it means?

Think about this statement: "God's truth doesn't change because culture decides it needs to." How do we love others like Christ when they believe that certain foundational truths need "updating" or are no longer relevant?

**Read Ephesians 4:15.** What should be the result of truth and love working together? Do you have an example of how this has happened in your own life? Maybe you have an example of when there was truth, but little love? Share if you're comfortable.

Jesus constantly demonstrated love through grace and truth in action. **Read John 7:53-8:11.** How is this a perfect example of love? In what ways does it inspire you? What will you do about it?

**Something to think about as we finish:**
