Group Discussion Guide

1. Have everyone in the group share and give a personal update: "what is something good in your life right now, for which you are thankful?"
2. Review the following quote from Aleksander Solzhenitsyn: *If only there were evil people somewhere insidiously committing evil deeds, and it were necessary only to separate them from the rest of us and destroy them. But the line dividing good and evil cuts through the heart of every human being.*

What do you think about when you read it and why?

3. Review the definition of what it means to love like Jesus: *Love is grace and truth in action*. Notice the three parts of this definition: grace, truth, action. See if you can reach a group consensus on the meaning of each of the three parts?
4. Read and discuss **John 1:14-18**. Describe how you have experienced both the grace and truth of Jesus? How has the combination impacted you personally? Explain?
5. Read **John 8:2-11**. What stands out to you in this story and why?
6. How has Jesus applied grace to your sins and how have you personally experienced him say to you: *"Go now and leave your life of sin?"*
7. Why must we first receive Jesus' grace and truth in action before we can show to others grace and truth in action? Explain how it works for you in practical terms today?
8. Close in prayer. Ask: how can we pray for each other this week.
