



**King Jesus is my President  
Group Discussion Guide  
November 1, 2020**

1. Have everyone in the group share and give a personal update: what is something good in your life right now for which you are thankful?
2. Review **Romans 14** and how Harpeth leadership wants to honor the choices that people make (encourage everyone to read [post on Romans 14 by Bobby](#) at Renew.org):
  - a. Choosing to isolate and watch online because of personal risk concerns
  - b. Choosing to attend, but wearing a mask and socially distancing
  - c. Choosing to attend without wearing a mask.

Ask: can everyone see the elders perspective based on **Romans 14** (we are not asking for agreement in this question, just understanding)?

3. Let's talk about how we can get everyone associated with the church as involved as possible in the life of the church, while honoring the different choices. How can we help the following people:
  - a. Not attending and only loosely engaged online.
  - b. Not attending, but engaged watching services online (only).
  - c. Not attending, but engaged watching services and in a group.
  - d. Attending services and group, wearing a mask for protection.
  - e. Attending services and group and not personally concerned to mask

Ask: how can we help each other in this season as COVID-19 is likely to spread further?

4. What do you think of the concept that Jesus is my King and I have pledged allegiance to him over all governments? How do you live out that teaching in your own life?
5. How can each of us help our families and our brothers and sisters to remember **Revelation 19:16** and **Revelation 21: 3-5**?
6. How can we best keep our eyes on Jesus and not get too engulfed in politics?
7. Close in prayer. Ask: how can we pray for each other this week?
