1. **Read Luke 10:1-16.** What stands out to you from these verses?
2. According to this passage, discuss the following:
 - God's part
 - The disciple's part (our part)
 - The recipient's partHow do you see these at work in your own life?
3. Why were the disciples instructed not to greet anyone on the road? How does this sense of urgency translate to your own life?
4. What does Jesus say about rejection? How much does fear of rejection have to do with your willingness to share Christ with others? How can it be overcome?
5. **Read Luke 10:17-24.** What stands out to you from these verses?
6. What are the disciples excited about? According to Jesus, what should be the focus of their rejoicing?
7. How often do you think about what it means to have your name "written in heaven?" What things keep us from really contemplating eternal destiny (our own and others)?
8. How does the certainty of your salvation (our greatest joy), and the eternal punishment of those who do not, directly affect your desire to share Christ with others?

ACTION: Think of one person where you live, work, or play who has yet to hear about the greatest joy in your life (share their name with the group)? How will you begin to share it with them? As a group, commit to pray for these people and for the Holy Spirit to prepare the way for conversations about the truth of Christ.
