Seek and Be Ready

Read Luke 12:4-7

1. What do you see in this passage that is sobering? What is encouraging?
2. How might this be offensive to someone who reads it and how can their feelings be addressed?

Read Luke 12:13-34

3. What challenges you the most from this passage?
4. Think about this statement: "*There are times when an eternal perspective is the hardest thing to come by. It's also typically when we need it the most.*" How would you rate yourself when it comes to maintaining an eternal perspective? What's the connection between an eternal perspective and seeking God's kingdom?

Read Luke 12:42-48

5. What do you think it means to be "ready" for the return of the Son of Man?

Read Luke 12:49-53

6. Everyone who truly trusts and follows Jesus will experience resistance, rejection, and division—often from their own family. Have you experienced this? What should our response be to the antagonists and to Christ followers we know who have been rejected?

ACTION: We're called to seek God's kingdom over anything this world can offer. Is there something that has been discouraging/distracting you from doing this? Set aside time each day this week to surrender it in prayer. Having someone (prayer partner) who will agree to pray with/for you is strongly encouraged.
