3. If you have committed yourself to Jesus through your baptism, did you understand at that time what it meant to be a disciple as defined in v33? How do you understand that differently now?
4. Our culture is continually changing what is good, what is acceptable. How do you guard against shifting your desires to those of the world instead of the unchanging desires of God's heart?
5. When talking to someone whom the Holy Spirit is drawing to Jesus, who is making the decision to make Jesus their Lord, how do you explain counting the cost of becoming a disciple?
6. What do you need to commit to for your life to become 'salty' in every area? What is the first step?
