- 1. In Acts 6, the early church faced growing pains even while being Spirit-filled.

- 2. With the guidance of the Holy Spirit, the apostles prioritized prayer and preaching while empowering others to serve.
 - What does it look like in your life or our church to keep the Word and service in healthy balance?
 - o Which side do you tend to lean toward?
- 3. Stephen was "full of grace and power," and opponents "could not resist the wisdom the Spirit gave him."
 - Can you think of a time when you sensed the Holy Spirit giving you words, courage, or clarity beyond yourself?
- 4. Stephen exposed a long history of God's people resisting the Spirit.
 - What are some subtle ways Christians today might resist the Holy Spirit's work, personally or collectively?
- 5. Using the "radio signal" analogy, what "static" most often drowns out the Spirit's voice in your daily life? What helps you tune back in?
- 6. Stephen's vision opened his eyes to Jesus while others hardened their hearts.
 - Is there a sin, fear, habit, or bitterness that the Spirit may be inviting you to release? What would freedom in that area look like?
- 7. Are there specific ways we can pray for one another to help each other not resist the Spirit's promptings in the coming week?
