James 1:5, 1 Corinthians 2:10-16

- 1. How would you define the difference between human "wisdom" and Holy Spirit-given wisdom?
- 2. Read James 1:5. What keeps us from asking God for wisdom?
- 3. Read 1 Corinthians 2:10–16 and then answer the following:
- a. Look at verse 10 and then verses 15 and 16. What do these verses say about the wisdom we receive through the Holy Spirit?
- b. How does knowing that all who have the Holy Spirit "have the mind of Christ" impact you? How often do you think about it? In what ways can this truth guide us?
 - 4. How often do you pause and listen for the Spirit's guidance before speaking? If comfortable, give examples of when you've done this and you knew that the Holy Spirit was guiding you in real-time.
 - 5. In what ways has the Holy Spirit given you insight into someone's pain, struggles, or deeper needs?
 - 6. Have you ever asked the Holy Spirit to give you insight and open doors to conversations with those who don't know Jesus and He did? What happened?
 - 7. Read Ephesians 1:15–17. What causes us to "know God better?" How does this relate to understanding his will for our lives?
 - 8. How can we receive wisdom from the Holy Spirit within community? Share a time when God spoke wisdom to you through another Christ-follower.

Now What?

- Where do you most need wisdom right now—in relationships, finances, decisions, conflict, parenting, work, etc.? Have someone in the group record the responses and distribute them to the group over text or Group Me. Check in throughout the week, encouraging each other in prayer.
- Spend time this week practicing pause in your conversations. Ask the Holy Spirit to guide you in real-time. Revisit this next week and share what happened with the group.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to give you insight and direct you to people who need to know Jesus. Ask him to guide you into conversations. Report back to the group on how it went.

This week, before reading a passage of scripture, pause and ask the Holy Spirit to open your heart and mind to the word. Ask for wisdom and insight to come from the word. Also ask, "What are You wanting me to see today?"
