- 1. What is your favorite Christmas memory, and why?
- 2. Read *Luke 1:30–33*. When have you sensed God saying "Do not be afraid" during a major change or overwhelming moment, and how did you respond?
- 3. In *Luke 1:32–33*, Gabriel says Mary's Son will be the eternal King. How does it affect you to realize that the King of the universe once depended on a teenage girl for his protection and care? How does this encourage you to seek God's guidance today?
- 4. Verse 31 says, "You shall call his name Jesus" (meaning "The Lord saves"). Why does that name mean so much to us in terms of the nature of Jesus? What specific area of your life right now most needs the saving power that this name promises?
- 5. Mary is told that her child "will be great" and will receive "the throne of his father David" and that "of his kingdom there will be no end." What does that promise mean to you personally? How can we promote that kingdom now?
- 6. Mary had to trust God with her reputation and future. What is the hardest thing God has asked you to trust Him with, and how does Mary's example encourage or challenge you now?
- 7. Imagine you were in Mary's place hearing these words for the first time. Which part of Gabriel's announcement (the favor of God, the virgin birth, the eternal throne, or something else) would have been the most difficult for you to accept, and why? How does reflecting on her "Yes" shape the way you want to respond to God's promises today?
