- 3. Luke 1:34- "How will this be," Mary asked the angel, "since I am a virgin?"
 - Was Mary challenging or asking for an explanation? What is the hardest promise to believe -for yourself- that God makes in scripture? Explain why and how you resolve the challenge.
- 4. Read Luke 1:35. On a personal and practical level, what do you find encouraging about the fact that Jesus was both fully human (born of Mary) and fully God (conceived by the Holy Spirit and called, The Son of God)? Explain? Which part of Jesus' nature human or God do you most naturally emphasize when you teach other people about him? Explain?
- 5. Luke 1:38- "I am the Lord's servant," Mary answered. "May your word to me be fulfilled." Then the angel left her.

What is your reaction to Mary's response to the Angel and why? In what specific ways can you be more like Mary when it comes to God's teachings for you? Explain?
