



Start Asking Some Questions

Ephesians 6:10-18

1. Let's start by reading Ephesians 6:10-18.

2. The sermon pushes against two ditches: blaming everything on demons vs. never looking behind the bushes. Where do you personally tend to drift?
3. The sermon's first "wake up" question is: "Could this be spiritual?" Think of a current struggle (temptation, discouragement, conflict, anxiety, isolation, burnout). How could you explain it in purely 'natural' categories?
 - a. Now, is there a way it could be spiritual in nature? Either in the flare-up itself, or once it began, how the enemy could have gotten involved.
4. Ephesians 6 says the armor is for standing against the devil's schemes. What are 1–2 schemes you see most often in your life or home (discouragement, accusation/shame, distraction, division, temptation, fear, isolation, deception)?
 - a. How can you pray against that, and what could 'taking ground' look like against that scheme this week?
 - b. One of the enemy's simplest schemes is isolation. Where are you most tempted to withdraw—emotionally, spiritually, or relationally? What would it look like to let this group "in" one step more?
5. The sermon emphasized a daily rhythm of prayer for protection / strength / guidance. If you actually prayed those three daily for a week, what do you think might change in your thought life, relationships, and decisions?
6. The sermon's second question was: "Do you believe there's more?" Where do you most need to believe that right now—more freedom, more peace, more joy, more self-control, more courage, more intimacy with God, etc.?
 - a. What's one next step that would be taking ground toward that "more"?

Let's take 5 minutes and pray protection/strength/guidance over each other.
