1. When you think about your past, especially growing up, what is one thing you felt that you did well?
2. Read Romans 12:3-8 twice to let it sink in: What stands out to you from this passage?
3. How does the instruction in Romans 12:3 to think of yourself with "sober judgment" challenge the way you view your own strengths and weaknesses in everyday life?
4. Reflecting on Romans 12:4-5, how and where have you experienced using your gifts in supporting others?
5. From the list of gifts in Romans 12:6-8, which one (like serving, teaching, or encouraging) do you identify with most personally, and how have you used it recently?
6. Review the following steps that help us identify and joyfully use our gifts. Which of these steps have you had personal experience with, and which ones do you desire to implement?
 - a. **Pray:** What are my gifts and what are the ministry opportunities?
 - b. What are my ministry interests and desires?
 - c. Experiment in different service areas.
 - d. Look for fruit.
 - e. Expect confirmation from others.
 - f. Enjoy God's blessings in serving.
7. Have group members access the Harpeth Hub and locate the Spiritual Gifts Inventory. Discuss how this can be helpful to better understand and use our gifts to serve others.
