1. **Icebreaker:** Share a recent moment-big or small-where you noticed God's goodness at work in your life.
2. What stood out to you from this week's sermon on spiritual warfare? How was it helpful or challenging for you?
3. Read Ephesians 2:1–4 (read twice)
 - Where do you see Satan's influence at work in our world today?
 - What does it mean for people to be objects of wrath (2:4) and what is your hope for these people?
 - How do these verses motivate or shape the way we engage with lost people?
4. Read Ephesians 6:10–20 (read twice)
 - What stands out to you most from this passage, and why?
 - Where have you learned—personally or through others—to rely on “the mighty power of God” (6:10) rather than your own strength?
5. What does it look like to “pray in the Spirit on all occasions” in everyday life? What is one practical way we can support or pray for one another this week as we put this into practice?
