1. Home Group Leaders: Please review with your group the reminders at the bottom.
2. In what ways do we “deceive ourselves” when we hear God’s Word without obeying it?
3. What is the purpose of the mirror illustration in verses 23-24?
4. In verse 25, James talks about someone who “looks intently” into God’s Word. How is that different from just casually hearing or reading it? How do you practice this?
5. Many Christ-followers have studied the Bible for years and believe this makes them spiritually mature. How does this passage challenge that?
6. What are some specific examples of Scriptures that are easy to understand, yet hard to obey?
7. What is a specific area where you have been convicted by God’s word but have not taken action? As individuals share as they feel led, stop and pray for strength and commitment to obedience.
8. In what ways does the perfect law bring freedom? How have you experienced this?

Action Steps This Week: Being a doer of the Word often starts with one simple step: apologizing, forgiving, serving, praying, telling the truth, resisting temptation, or changing a habit. This week, do not just ask, “What did I learn from God’s Word?” Ask, “What did I do because of God’s Word?”
